

In order to maintain the CRP line of products, we highly recommend the following to keep products looking clean and new.

- <u>Mr. Clean Magic Eraser</u>
- <u>303[®] Patio Furniture Cleaner</u> which is specifically designed to clean resin and plastic furniture
- <u>303[®] Patio Furniture Protectant</u> which is the world's most powerful UV screening product.
- Soapy water and sponge
- Earth Scrub

** What to avoid: Pressure Washer. When nozzle is placed too close to the plastic it could chew/fray the plastic leaving a fuzzy look to the plastic and allowing atmospheric dirt and particles to get inside the plastic. Over time the furniture looks dirty and will never clean to its original look.

Earth Scrub Recipe

- 16 oz bottle
- Measure carefully
- Mix 1 2/3 cups baking soda with ½ cup of liquid *soap** in a bowl
- Add 2 tbsp vinegar <u>last</u>
- Stir until the lumps are gone
- If you can pour it into the container easily, then you have the right consistency. If it's too thick, add more water.
- Keep cap on because this mixture will dry out.
- Shake well before using

How to Use

Squirt it anywhere such as the tub, sink, toilet bowl, floors, garbage cans and any greasy, grimy job. Use it with a nylon white-backed sponge to prevent scratching. Rinse well. A vinegar rinse may help to prevent mold and mildew. In this cleaner, the baking soda and soap will tend to separate, so make sure to shake well before using.

Effectiveness Rating: 90% - 100%

Commercial Brand vs Earth Scrub (26 oz tub and tile cleaner): \$3.50 vs \$1.60 * <u>liquid soap</u> = castile soaps (ie Dr. Bronner's Soap) are the best but another option is

Palmolive (for sensitive skin) or Ivory Liquid Soaps. Do not use dishwashing detergent.
